



A) Terms and Conditions for Scholarship Based on Academic Results:

1. Eligibility Criteria: To be considered for the scholarship based on academic results, the student must meet the specified eligibility criteria, which may include minimum GPA requirements, academic excellence, completion of specific courses, or other academic achievements.
2. Verification of Academic Records: NIM reserves the right to verify the student's academic records, grades, and achievements to ensure they meet the eligibility criteria for the scholarship.
3. Academic Performance: To maintain the scholarship, the student is required to maintain a specified level of academic performance, which may include maintaining a certain GPA or academic standing each semester or academic year.
4. Full-Time Enrollment: The student must be enrolled as a full-time student as defined by the institution to be eligible for the scholarship. Part-time students may not qualify for the scholarship unless otherwise specified.

B) Terms and Conditions for Scholarship Based on Special Skills:

1. C Terms and Conditions for Scholarship Based on Representing School in Major Competitions, Seminars, or Conferences:

1. Eligibility Criteria: The student must meet the specified eligibility criteria for the scholarship based on representing NIM in major competitions, seminars, or conferences, which may include significant participation, recognition, or awards in events that showcase the school's reputation and academic excellence.

2. Full-Time Enrollment: The student must be enrolled as a full-time student as defined by the institution to be eligible for the scholarship. Part-time students may not qualify for the scholarship unless otherwise specified.

3. School Endorsement: The student's participation in major competitions, seminars, or conferences representing the school must be officially endorsed or recognized by the school authorities. Documentation of the school's endorsement may be required as part of the scholarship application process.

4. Application Process: The student must inform NIM through Student Services staff along with relevant documentation of their representation of the school in major events, conferences, or seminars before the commencement of the competition, seminars, or conference so that the record is captured to be considered for the scholarship.

5. Verification of Representation: The scholarship provider may verify the student's representation of the school in major competitions, seminars, or conferences through school officials, event organizers, or other verification methods to confirm the student's active participation and contributions.

6. Contribution Assessment: The scholarship award committee (President or Vice President as assigned by the President) may evaluate the student's contributions, performance, leadership, and impact in representing the school in major events as part of the scholarship evaluation process.

7. Scholarship Renewal: Some scholarships based on representing the school in major competitions, seminars, or conferences may be renewable based on continued active

participation, achievements, and contributions in relevant events, as well as adherence to the scholarship terms and conditions. The student must fulfill any renewal criteria to continue receiving the scholarship.

8. Reporting Responsibilities: The student is responsible for reporting any additional representation of the school in major events during the scholarship period to demonstrate ongoing commitment and contributions to the school's reputation and academic standing.
